THE PROJECT:

The project entailed the upgrading of the airport approach road from a single carriageway to a dual carriageway facility, in addition to the upgrading of an overhead bridge and interchange ramps.

THE APPOINTMENT:

The design process included the study of the required improvements with regard to future traffic volumes, budgetary constraints, stormwater management, improved lighting and road signage.

Design and construction of the road was undertaken such that it allowed uninterrupted access for the airport user.

OUTCOME:

An improved road system constructed within budget and estimated contract period with no major disruptions for airport users.
